

Kenyan Runner Kipkorir Won the "Marathon International de Tana" 2014

The Kenyan runner Sammy Kibet Kipkorir won the 14th edition of the "Marathon International de Tana" on October 26 with the lap time 2h25'24". He edged the champion of Madagascar Hajanirina Andriamparany with a little over three minute lap time. So the Kenyan took home the trophy and the 1.5 million Ariary (600 \$USD), the prizes of the marathon's winner.

In the women's draw, the Malagasy Ramanantenaso Marina finished the 42.195 km distance in 3h21'27". She edged Landinirina Ratinarison in only 6". The women's podium is completed by Elysee Razafimahatratra who is credited



with a lap time of 3h33'20".

More than 600 runners participated in the October 26 event. 160 of them participated in the

traditional marathon while 428 others took part in the "Foulees de Tana", a 5km race open to all age beyond 12. In addition, 28

people with disabilities could also enjoy the atmosphere of the marathon by running the 5km distance race called "Handirun".

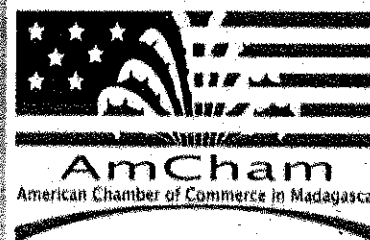
